Application Process for IGEM Undergraduate Scholarships

CLOSING DATE FOR APPLICATIONS: 30 April 2021.

1. Acknowledgement of application form

You will be sent confirmation from the Scholarship Panel upon receipt of your application.

2. What happens next?

Your application and reference form will be assessed by the Scholarship Panel.

The Scholarship Panel meets in May to select candidates to invite to interview. Candidates who are short-listed will be contacted by email. This is the earliest date which candidates can be notified.

Candidates short-listed for interview will be required to supply the following information

Confirmation of your A-Level (or equivalent) results (photocopies or pdfs please), if available

As a matter of urgency, please email the Scholarship Panel and let them know your A-Level (or equivalent) results as soon as you receive them, quoting your name and reference number. Please also forward a copy of these results either as a pdf or a photocopy in the post. Please email funding@igem.org.uk.

Confirmation of your university place (photocopy/scanned copy please)

A reference to support your application (to be sent by your referee under separate cover no later than 30 April)

Candidates who have **not** been short-listed for an interview will be informed by email, after the meeting in May

PLEASE NOTE THAT THE SCHOLARSHIP PANEL WILL NOT ENTER INTO ANY CORRESPONDENCE REGARDING ITS DECISION.

3. Interviews

Interviews for short-listed candidates have been arranged for July 2021. ***We regret that an alternative date cannot be arranged.***

4. What happens at the interview day?

Those short-listed will be invited to attend a virtual interview with the Scholarship Panel. The interview will last approximately 45 minutes and will be based on your application submitted.

If you have any additional requirements to assist you to attend your interview, please notify us in advance so that we can organise the necessary arrangements.

5. After the interview

Following the interview, the Scholarship Panel will notify applicants of the outcome of the interview via email.

NOTE: APPLICANTS MUST BEAR IN MIND THAT THE SCHOLARSHIP PANEL DOES NOT OFFER FEEDBACK FROM THE INTERVIEW AND ITS DECISION IS FINAL.

6. Successful applicants

Successful applicants will be sent an offer email outlining the amount agreed by the Scholarship Panel.



This will include a reminder of the conditions attached to the scholarship i.e. that they will be required to become a member and also details of when a report(s) is required.

Failing to comply with these conditions will mean that IGEM is entitled to ask for a reimbursement of the Scholarship.

Successful applicants are required to notify the IGEM in writing that they still require the scholarship and accept the conditions of supplying a report on the date determined by the Scholarship Panel and becoming a member of IGEM.

Upon receipt of the confirmation, IGEM will arrange for payment.
